New Edition Of ITIL V3

- September 2009: OGC published a “Mandate For Change”
- October 2009: OGC published an FAQ document
- November 2009: OGC announced plans to withdraw ITIL V2 starting:
 - V2 Foundation June, 30 2010
 - V2 Service Manager August 31, 2010
 - V2 Practitioners December 31, 2010
 - V2-V3 Foundation Bridge December 31, 2010
 - V2-V3 Manager’s Bridge June 2011
 - V2 books June 30, 2011



ITIL V3 Examination Statistics

- Since the launch of ITIL V3 in May 2007:
 - Almost 500,000 ITIL exams have been taken
 - 60% - ITIL V3; 5% went beyond Foundation
 - 40% - ITIL V2; 16% went beyond Foundation
- Pass Rates:
 - Foundation – 90%
 - Intermediate – 62% - 90%
 - Manager's Bridge – 68%



Software Certification Scheme

- Pink Elephant has managed an ITIL software certification program called PinkVERIFY since 1999
- In September 2009 OGC & APMG announced the launch of an official ITIL Software Scheme.
 - Bronze: product & documentation meets the required standard
 - Silver: additionally the product has been successfully implemented at least 3 times
 - Gold: additionally 3 clients have provided positive testimonials of their successful implementations



Software Certification Scheme

- In the months leading up to the announcement by OGC & APMG, Pink Elephant worked with APMG to validate that the criteria and process for PinkVERIFY would be compatible with the new Scheme.
- The OGC/APMG Software Certification Scheme sets a minimum standard; PinkVERIFY sets a higher standard (scope & integration)
- Going forward any ITSM software product that passes the PinkVERIFY standard will also qualify for the bronze level of the official ITIL Software Scheme.
